Main Responsibilities

- Store and locate all vehicles on site between the yard and the auction hall
- Line and lot vehicles for auction, ensuring they are presentable for auction
- Site, transfer, and release vehicles in line with G3 Remarketing Gating Process
- Image vehicles in line with current G3 systems in place
- Always maintain a safe driving standard and adhere to speed limits on site
- Ensure health and safety standards and practices are adhered to in the yard and auction hall so that near misses, accidents to vehicles and customers are prevented
- Carry out any other tasks in the yard department to ensure that operational requirements are met
- Manage, control, and monitor vehicle movement on site
- Be responsible for jump starting vehicles when needed
- Maintain good housekeeping in the yard and work areas at all times
- Ensuring upkeep of all tools, property, and services
- Working closely with Management, Transport, and other departments always
- Taking written and verbal instructions

Other tasks may include

- Unlock / Lock facility buildings if required
- Work later hours when circumstances / operations dictate
- To promote equal opportunities and diversity in service delivery

- To participate in the continuous improvement of service delivery ensuring that policies and procedures comply with legislation and regulatory requirements
